Great Expectations

Dickens himself considered Great Expectations to be his best work of art. The plot is set in between 1812 and 1840 in Kent and London, and is full of action, suspense, unexpected twists and extreme imagery.

Dickens' 'Great Expectations' was first published in 1860-61.

A Christmas Carol

A Christmas Carol was published in 1843. This is a tale of miserly and bitter Ebenezer Scrooge's transformation on a number of levels – emotional, ethical and ideological. The transformation is caused by various ghosts visiting Scrooge.

The novella became very popular immediately. Voices of the critics were also favourable.

Dickens' 'A Christmas Carol' changed Christmas forever, promoting family gatherings, charitable giving and merriment.

David Copperfield

David was born half-orphan, as his father died before his birth. His mother re-marries, but new family does not bring happiness for David. The plot unfolds, David rents a room at a house of Mr Wickfield who lives with his daughter Agnes, who becomes David's friend. Soon, David meets Dora and the story gets complicated. Few more characters are vital for the plot, but ... you need to find it out yourself!

David Copperfield was first published in instalments in 1849-1850, full version followed in 1858.

Oliver Twist

The plot of the novel is set in a provincial town in England, and later in London and other places. The main Character, Oliver Twist, is an orphan who was placed in a child workhouse. This is a very unpleasant place, as cold, hunger and abusive treatment of children are prevalent in the institution. He is expelled, and has a stint at the undertakers business, but due to human malice he has to run. He arrives in London and the story gains momentum, but ... you need to find it out yourself!

Oliver Twist was first published in instalments in 1837-1839.

There was a number of adaptations of 'Oliver Twist' for screen and stage, the most recent movie adaptation in 2005 by Roman Polanski.

Hard Times

The novel touches on the very important questions about the society, but in a simple way without hidden meanings. Charles Dickens' novel, in his appraisal of the society, shows us the social and economic pressures of the Victorian era.

Hard Times was first published in 1854.

Bleak House

The plot is set around an inheritance case called Jarndyce vs. Jarndyce. The case has been in the courts (Court of Chancery, civil court) for generations. Esther Summerson, raised by her aunt, the main character, is later adopted by John Jarndyce (who also adopts two others, Ada and Richard). Lady Dedlock and her attorney Tulkinghorn are pivotal to the plot. Bleak House is really a fascinating piece of writing.

Bleak House was first published in 1852-1853.
